

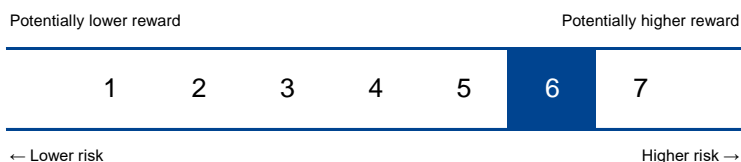
Global Dividend Strategy Fund

Charakteristik

Der Global Dividend Strategy Fund (GDSF) hat auf Portfolioebene die Erzielung überdurchschnittlich hoher laufender Ausschüttungen unter Berücksichtigung von Kursschwankungen (Volatilität) zum Ziel. Um über entsprechende Selektionsmöglichkeiten zu verfügen ist sein Anlageuniversum sehr breit gefasst. Das Hauptaugenmerk richtet sich dabei auf großkapitalisierte, dividendenstarke Aktien, die auf repräsentativen europäischen und nordamerikanischen Börsen notieren und über entsprechende Liquidität verfügen. In Bezug auf Sektoren liegen keine Einschränkungen vor. Der GDSF wird aktiv gemanaged.

Zumindest 51% des Fondsvermögens müssen in Aktien investiert sein. Unter Bedachtnahme auf das Investmentziel und die Anlagerichtlinien des Fonds kann darüber hinaus in Geldmarktinstrumente, Anleihen, Investmentzertifikate und mit bis zu 10% in andere Investmentfonds, investiert werden. Fremdwährungsrisiken dürfen ebenfalls innerhalb der definierten Grenzen eingegangen werden, Derivate können zur Absicherung eingesetzt werden.

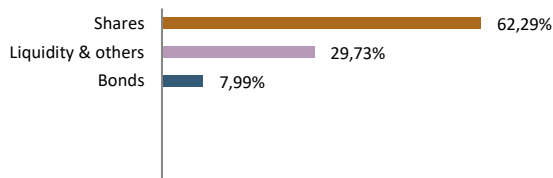
Risk and Reward Profile



The synthetic risk reward indicator (SRRI) indicates the amount of the historical fluctuation/volatility of the fund price on a scale of 1 to 7. Funds with a low SRRI typically feature lesser price fluctuations and are thus less likely to suffer interim capital losses. Funds with a high SRRI are typically subject to greater fluctuations and also to a greater risk of suffering capital losses.
